
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

PCA'S BIGGEST EVENT RETURNS TO MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA JUNE 15-21.

THE 59TH ANNUAL Porsche Parade will be held in iconic Monterey, California this coming June. Hundreds of Porsches will descend on the area for a week of competitive and social events. With the event based at the Monterey Hyatt-just minutes from the Pacific Ocean-Parade-goers will be treated to Highway 1, California's legendary vineyards, Monterey's best attractions, and the hills and valleys that surround Laguna Seca.

Registration opens on April 1, 2014, and be sure to register early. While Parades no longer "sell out"-as neither the Welcome Party nor the Parade Concours are limited in terms of how many members can attend-the Hyatt Regency Monterey Hotel & Spa has only so many rooms, and many Parade activities are quickly filled to capacity.

Kickoff: Sunday, June 15

Check-in is open on Sunday, June 15 from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. It's the only time that all event chairs will be in one place to answer questions, make sure you have the tickets you want, and verify that you're classified for competitive events correctly. Late check-in is available after Sunday, but competitive events require you to be checked in ahead of time. Check out the Parade Competition Rules at parade2014.pca.org for details.

Let the games begin

The competitive events start up with Monday's Parade Concours on the beautiful fairways of the Monterey Hyatt. Don't be intimidated by the word "concours" or the perfectionism of some of the more ardent participants. This really is just a car show-and we'd really love to see your Porsche take part in it. To that end, we have classes for every Porsche and stage of preparation, from "Full" preparation to a "Street" class where only the interior and exterior are judged. You will be surprised by the people you'll meet and what you can learn about your car.

Tuesday's Mobil 1 TSD Rally is set to take us to the beautiful beaches, vineyards, hills, and forests in the area. Never rallied before? No worries: We'll be offering the TSD Rally School on Monday evening.

On Wednesday and Thursday, the Michelin Autocross will be staged at the nearby Marina Airport. New Autocross Chair Leeds Gulick has won the Parade autocross overall several times in the past and promises a fun, challenging course.

Whether you study up or simply show up, Friday's Parade Technical/ Historical Quiz is a way to show you know your favorite cars...or teach you something new about them.

Test drive a new Porsche

Michelin's Drive & Compare is your chance to take a couple of laps in identical new Porsches with two different types of tires. Better yet, Porsche will supply the cars and Michelin will supply the tires. Just be sure to sign up at check-in; we've had full rosters for this event in the past.



Thursday's Gimmick Rally is scored and trophies are given, but you don't have to approach it that way—it's about fun. You'll see Cannery Row and 17-Mile Drive while stopping at the Lone Cypress, Otter Cove, Pebble Beach, and more. Expect a minimum driving time of three hours.

Tour the area

Traditional driving tours in your Porsche as well as guided van/motorcoach tours will be offered throughout the week, and special recognition will be earned for the most tour miles driven by an individual and region this year. All tours include lunch. Tours include PCA on PCH, James Dean's Last Drive, Hearst Castle, and an off-road Cayenne Tour. More tours are in the works, though some may be very limited in size. 




Academy Accreditation. Five sessions earn you a "Doctorate," four sessions a "Master's," three sessions a "Bachelor's," and two sessions an "Associate."


T-Shirt Contest

Fees and more information

When signing up for Parade you must pay the entrant fee of \$169, which covers the entrant and co-entrant. Tickets to banquets, competitive events, and other activities can then be purchased—with entrants choosing only those activities they are interested in. For example, the Concours is \$30 per car, the autocross is \$30 per driver, the TSD Rally is \$15 per car, and the Tech/Historical Quiz is \$15 per person.
